MENU OF SERVICES

CONSULTANCY

£350 PER DAY

We provide support, advice, outreach and specialist training within schools to support positive behaviour management. Our main aim is to work with schools to identify pupils' needs and provide strategies of support in the reduction of disruptive behaviour and exclusions in key stages 2-4. Our main areas of expertise are:

1. Support where appropriate with gathering evidence for EHC assessments.
2. Supporting SEN pupils
3. Curriculum Development, support, assessment and planning
4. Engaging the disengaged
5. A range of therapeutic interventions such as Art Therapy, SEAL, B More Archie etc.
6. Mental Health
7. Counselling Services

CPD

£250 (TWILIGHT) £500 (FUL DAY)

We provide tailor made CPD for your staff on a range of key areas including Behaviour Management, Attachment Disorders, working with anxious pupils, planning, curriculum development, assessment, marking and feedback. Please call us to discuss your training needs.

TEAM TEACH (from November 2018) £500 (UPTO 24 PEOPLE)

Team Teach is a certificated holistic approach to supporting behaviour across the school. The course is a 6-hour long foundation course focusing on de-escalation and physical intervention. This can be delivered as two 3-hour twilights or a full day training, this includes summary evaluation. Due to licences, it is only possible to deliver this training to Stockton Local Authority Schools. An additional £5 per person is charged for Team Teach Handbook and certificate.

ALTERNATIVE PROVISION

Use of good quality AP can be an effective strategy for keeping a pupil engaged whilst they continue to remain on the roll of their school however this is something that can be far easier said than done. The Bishopton has the benefit of an experienced Broker of AP who can support you in a variety of ways as a costed service. Examples of support are:

1. Purchase (constantly updated) which details Provision available locally and regionally. **£80**
2. Purchase of AP directory, QA Framework (personalised to your school's colours, branding and logos) and pupil tracking forms. Consultation at school to look at pupil's needs and identify suitable AP and establish an SLA between the school and the provision. **£300**
3. Full Brokerage – needs identified, AP sourced, attendance, behaviour and attainment monitored and reported to the school 6 weekly (no pastoral support offered) **£1250 Per term**
4. Full Brokerage plus pastoral support **TBA**

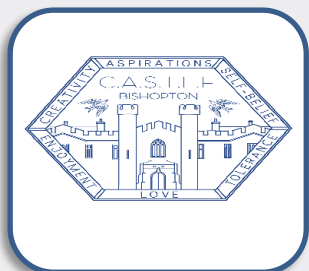

PSYCHOLOGY SERVICES

£35 PER HOUR

Bishopton has the benefit of a member of staff who has an MSc in Clinical Psychology who can offer schools support with a range of therapeutic interventions in Attachment using, for example Theraplay®. This service could involve 1:1 session/s with pupil, formal assessments, small group observations and signposting. For a discussion of this service and your needs please contact us.

IN-BISHOPTON SUPPORT

£150 PER DAY

Bishopton is a good place to visit, we have often shown pupils and parents/carers around to get an idea of what PRU life is like. We have also welcomed professionals in from mainstream and other PRUs to spend the day with us observing lessons, behaviour management, engaging challenging pupils etc. and we would welcome any professional in for a free initial meeting, subsequent visits will incur a cost. In addition to this we have rooms (with refreshments) to hire for small meetings or larger CPD/Conference events. Please contact us to discuss further.

CORE BUSINESS (*Partnership Placements*)

£12500 PER YEAR

At Bishopton we offer partnership places to schools in Key Stages, 2, 3 & 4. This offers schools the opportunity to refer pupils who are getting close to a permanent exclusion in order that their behaviour can be explored in depth, strategies identified and their education is tailored to their specific needs. The focus is on successful re-engagement back into mainstream or provide appropriate support to pupils, parents and schools in securing the next stage in the most suitable educational provision. The placements are limited to 12 weeks.

BUILDING BRIDGES PROGRAMME

£13000 2 SPACES

At the Bishopton we firmly believe that early intervention is the key to unlocking pupil's potential. The sooner pupils' needs are identified and met the quicker they can engage and start to experience joy in their learning which will ultimately impact on their behaviour. Aimed at year 7 and 8 the Building Bridges Programme is a bespoke 6-week programme to address the pupils' needs. At 1 pupil per cohort schools can access the following:

Tier 1 – Early identification and in-school support for pupils who are starting to struggle with school life.

Tier 2 – Building Bridges Programme based at the Bishopton full-time over 6 weeks' pupils will be offered tailored interventions in English, maths as well as PSHE, PE and SEAL and a wealth of enrichment activities to develop pupils' SMSC. The aim is to reintegrate back into mainstream after the 6 weeks' programme.

Tier 3 – Exit strategy and in-school support with assigned mentor to aid positive re-integration back into mainstream.

POLICIES/PR/MARKETING

£300 PER DAY

With many years' middle and senior leadership experience, Bishopton is able to offer schools a policy writing service as well as other reports, proposals, strategies and marketing material i.e. school brochures/newsletters etc. We are also able to design and print bespoke displays and posters and support with bid writing and Quality Marks.
